

# Friends of Turnbull Kids Scavenger Hunt List

Put an X by the items on the list that you can find on your trip around Turnbull National Wildlife Refuge. Some will be easier find than others, depending on the time of the year. You may also want to take a picture for your notes.



- Columbia Ground Squirrel (check near the Refuge Headquarters and the education building)
- Ponderosa Pine tree
- Trumpeter Swan
- Western Bluebird nesting box (look on the trees/fences, as you go through the Refuge)
- Animal tracks or scat on the paths (use your tracking guide to see who they belong to)
- White-Tailed Deer
- Pinecone that's been taken apart by a chipmunk or squirrel in search of the inner pine nuts
- Red squirrel or  Chipmunk
- Visitor with a hat and binoculars
- Duck      bonus:  diving duck    or     dabble (tail-up) duck
- Cattail plant (this will be in a marsh or wetland area)
- Hawk (Red-Tailed is the most common, then the Northern Harrier)
- Snag (a standing dead tree that serves as habitat for many species)
- Feather on the ground
