Beginning Bird Watching Classes will meet on the first Saturday mornings of April, May and June from 8:45 am to noon. Gather in the Turnbull National Wildlife Refuge Classroom Building.

Choose one: April 1, May 6, or June 3, 2017

The classes will include:

- 1) recognize size, shape, beak, color to identify birds,
- 2) instruction and practice using binoculars,
- 3) use field guides (books and phone apps),
- 4) list birds to look for at Turnbull NWR; walk around Pine Lake trail.



Participants: individuals, couples, families with children, 8 and older welcome when accompanied by an adult. Bring along any binoculars – we will practice using them!

Sign up for one session – each session limited to 15 participants. Classes are free with the \$3.00/car entrance fee to Refuge.
